It was nice for the residents to make connections with one another. Some had never met one another as fellow members of GS.

Pastor Sheryl thanked everyone for celebrating her 35 year ordination anniversary.

Showcase a Committee Ministry - Shepherd's Hands - Kathie

The group began at Verona campus and was led by MaryJo Manke (who did not know how to knit!) They meet from 1:30 - 3:00pm every 3rd Thursday, even months at Verona and odd months at Madison. Projects include prayer shawls, prayer squares, 6" squares that are sent to Pine Ridge, and hats and scarves for the food pantry (are there any other places that are in need of these items? Kimberly can ask Social Action Committee for ideas and inquire if they are needed for the Shoeboxes). The newest project is making Baptismal Blankets. Approximately 14 have already been made to be given out at Baptisms. The yarn for these blankets was purchased through the 2021 budget, totaling approximately \$160. Kits were made available to knitters/crocheters. When a blanket is finished it is turned in at the church to Jessica or Judy. Quite a bit of yarn is donated for hats and scarves. Some members purchase their own yarn. Pat emails about 40 members to remind them of meetings and projects; usually 5-15 members attend meetings while others continue to knit/crochet at home. Pat, Kathie or Barb Friberg are contacts for questions about this ministry.
