- 1. Mike Devotion- Uniting weekly practice among all Lutherans is Communion
- 2. Recap-Summer Worship
 - a. #s have been consistent
 - b. Worship days/times/services
 - i. Thursday nights
 - 1. 30-60, average 40 people- mainly Good Shepherd members
 - 2. Not main service of attendance
 - ii. Outdoor services this summer have been challenging but hope to still have in August and maybe September (weather permitting).
- 3. Fall Worship
 - a. Previous suggestion- perhaps changing Verona 10:30am service to earlier (10:00am)- Recommendation of WMA committee to Board to have service times remain the same (continue the consistency)
 - i. Recommendation allows for easy addition of more services, if/when capacity is reached and the need is there.
- 4. Tracking Attendance
 - a. Currently tracked by Rick Blum
 - i. Jared with share with the group
 - ii. Could we share with the congregation on a regular cadence?
- 5. Associate Director of Music
 - a. 3 applicants
 - i. 1 not a good fit
 - ii. 1 not available for a fulltime position
 - iii. 1 did not play piano or guitar
 - b. Keeping job posting open to wait for the right fit
 - c. In the meantime, we can be creative with near-term youth music volunteers
- 6. Strategic Planning
 - a. Worship section- opinions voiced on wording; very broad and needs more detail.
 - b. Document is meant to be a living/breathing document that invites the work to come; document is a starting point and has not been rolled out yet; multi-year process and need work to carve out the details for implementation.
 - i. There may be an opportunity to bring in people to help key down the lay out the details for implementation

- ii. Can the folks who were involved in fleshing out the worship "pillar" of the strategic planning, come talk to our committee and walk us through the thought process?
- c. Future suggestions
 - i. Liaison between Hospitality and WMA committees or combine the two committee meetings a few times throughout the year.
 - ii. Recognition that there is a lot of overlap between the WMA and Hospitality Committees.
