- 1. Welcome (Mike)
 - a. 2022 reflection on accomplishments- proud of work the committee is doing

- 2. Devotion- Question posed instead
 - a. How many resolve to have a closer relationship with god?
 - b. Always good to re-evaluate your faith walk.

- 3. Strategic Planning Update (Betsy, Karen, Jared)
 - a. Task 1- define what worship is to us.
 - i. Met with pastoral staff (mid-Nov)

 - i. Are families choosing earlier services?
 - ii. 4:30/6pm transition can be congested → give more time in between.
 - f. Push out family blessing day to Sunday after New Years to offer to families who are typically out of town over the holidays.
