- 1. Devotion (mini)- Jared
 - a. Music Monday inspiration- Jesus Loves Me.
- 2. Feedback/reflection- online worship
 - a. Really enjoying the format.
 - b. Very nice collaboration among the consistent worship leaders.
 - c. Do the key players need more frequent breaks? Jared and Sarah assured us that they could openly ask for a break if they were getting burned out and appreciate the concern.
- **3.** Fall planning
 - a. Should we continue with the Wed service?
 - i. The committee as a whole enthusiastically agree to continue to support a Wednesday service indefinitely!!- will revisit the discussion when we move to Phase 3.
 - ii. Fairly high numbers >/=~100.
 - iii. Lots of energy.
 - iv. Offers an option for folks would cannot normally make a Sunday worship.
 - b. We should keep all virtual services going, even when we phase transition.
 - c. Music Mondays, consistently get >1000 hits.
- **4.** Christmas planning
 - a. Hard to plan right now because unclear where we will "be".
 - b. Should start scenario planning soon.
 - c. Can start deeper discussions at October meeting.
- 5. Associate Music Director- Applications
 - a. Put a pause on hiring this position until we can offer ample opportunity to contribute to the congregation (Phase 2 to resume forward progress, but most likely will not hire until after holiday season/phase 3).
 - b. Continue to communicate with all 3 applicants on a regular basis to check in on availability and interest.
- **6.** Phase 3 re-opening worship logistics
 - a. We hope to be in phase 2 by end of September (if guidelines are met).
 - i. If we move forward into phases more quickly before our next meeting we can communicate via email.

- b. Passionate pleas to consider keeping up with the state phase change and not lag behind; we need to be mindful of all comfort levels when opening back up and make sure we maintain an online presence.
- c. Facilities and task force committees meeting within next few weeks and we will discuss their plans/recommendations at next meeting.
- d. Our committee's main focus:
 - i. How can we facilitate the changes that will come with moving into new phases?
 - ii. Jared to send out sheet of activities in planning.
- e. Key points of discussion:
 - i. Let's start discussion of change of flow, but we do not necessarily need to rush into anything as soon as phase change → be purposeful.
 - ii. Be conscious of finding the appropriate balance → remember our heads and our hearts through our faithful discussion on this topic.
 - iii. Sign-up will be part of phase 2 protocol
 - 1. Offers options for all comfort levels.
 - 2. Give ownership to the congregation to make own choices.
 - iv. Survey where people are and what they want to see in the church community.
 - v. Talk to friends and family who are going are attending worship in-person and hear their experiences (what worked, what didn't).
