Opening prayer / Devotion: Amy provided the opening devotion based on 1 Kings:17, the story of drought in ancient Israel in which there wasn't rain or dew for three years. Elijah was led to water by the ravens. Are we meant to be miraculous ravens that lead others to Christ?

Approval of minutes/Note Taker: Amy asked for any comments or changes to the May minutes. None were suggested and the minutes were approved. Kay offered to take the minutes in Ann's absence.

Video Projects: Ongoing/future projects: Eric and Emma reported that they have been attending various events at which they have captured video for blog posts/social media/website. One event they captured was the opening of a time capsule buried about eight years ago by the youth who are now graduating seniors. They also are capturing faith journey stories at the campfires, did a livestream of Music Monday on June 14 and will do it again on June 21. Emma also captured the Holy Cow in action when they were serving coffee and treats to public health providers.
